### Q. When are PAGS Delegate meetings held?

The PAGS Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held the third Monday of April each year. Regular PAGS Delegate meetings are held the second Monday of September and the third Monday of November each year. ### Q. What is the coverage area of PAGS?

PAGS currently has teams from all of EPYSA, all of Delaware, northern Maryland, and southern New Jersey.

### Q. When does PAGS offer league play?

PAGS currently has a fall season games that runs from early September to early November, and a spring season (6 games) that runs from early April to late May each year. In addition, PAGS offers a short season (3 games) for U15-U19 teams in mid November. The short season is used primarily by teams interested in becoming cup qualified.
